Structure of the Governing Body

Here at Mayfield our Governing Body is made up as follows:

- 1 Headteacher
- 1 Local Authority Governor
- 2 Parent Governors
- 1 Staff Governor
- 9 Co-opted Governors

Our Governors are all volunteers and give their time freely. They are all committed to ensuring that Mayfield Primary School provides the best educational experience possible for the pupils. In broad terms they are responsible for setting the strategic vision for the school; the school ethos; monitoring school performance and making sure the budget is well planned to benefit the children.

We hold a Full Governing Body each Autumn, Spring and Summer Term.

In addition we meet as two Committees each term; Resources and Standards and Effectiveness.

Overview of the Resources Committee:

This committee has a focus on the school's effectiveness in terms of:

- the quality of provision for all pupils – including those with SEN and those eligible for Pupil Premium. They hold the school to account and set the budget accordingly.
- the staffing structure of the school and ensuring adequate provision to meet the needs of all pupils.
- the effectiveness of the school's Appraisal system and provision for staff training.
- the health and safety at school.
- planning and budgeting for school improvement projects.
- the allocation of Pupil Premium and Sports Premium.

Overview of the Standards and Effectiveness Committee:

This committee has a focus on the school's effectiveness in terms of:

- shaping the School Improvement Plan and setting the school priorities in terms of the outcomes for pupils.
- monitoring the progress pupils are making and ensuring the provision is effective.
- interrogating the data relating to pupil attainment and holding the school to account for pupil outcomes.
- monitoring the effectiveness of communication with parents.
- monitoring the effectiveness of behaviour and welfare of pupils; including attendance data.
