## THE SITUATION WHEN THIS APPLIES

In the event that your child's class bubble is unable to attend school, we have outlined below our latest, extensive daily learning package. This will be available for each of the bubble school closure days. This offer takes effect immediately but clearly will only ever happen should the affected bubble close within school.

#### IMPORTANT MESSAGES

- It is not an offer for individual isolation (through choice or otherwise), it relates to bubble and whole school It will not be offered during INSET Days, Bank Holidays, School Holidays, Saturdays or Sundays.
- It will be actively managed by the child's class teacher only between 8.45am and 3.15pm on the appropriate days.
- Individual pupil isolation is different to a bubble closure. If an individual has been directed to isolate or is required Teachers will be unavailable between 12.00pm and 1.00pm on these days. to isolate and is 'fit for school' the child's teacher will make contact as soon as possible and support some home learning activities. Keeping in touch as appropriate. This will be personalised to suit each situation and therefore
- Individual pupil isolation, which has not been directed or required by the government at the time of happening, does not form part of this offer as school is open and available for learning for that specific child.
- All offers will commence on the first full day of a bubble/school closure. It will not appear if a bubble closes after An exercise book and pencil will be offered to each child. These should not return at the end of the isolation
- Any ICT related concern can be relayed to school using the APP or email to file a message. If we can solve the problem or assist we will. You may need to be patient with this. There will be limitations in what we can do. We
- You should not phone school with remote learning queries during such bubble/school closures as the school office may be unable to accept or deal with calls. Please use the APP or email options. We cannot guarantee a

- A timetable will be posted on Purple Mash and on the class website page by 8.45am each school day. The timetable will consist of four sessions daily: English; Maths; Two other curriculum subjects.
- Resources will be uploaded, in timetable order, onto Purple Mash.
- Files will be named by subject and the school isolation day in line with the published timetable. E.G. ENGLISH DAY ONE, MATHS DAY SEVEN, SCIENCE DAY THREE
- Between 8.45am and 3.15pm you can contact your child's teacher directly using the Purple Mash blog to ask duestions about any aspect of the work. The teacher's will reply via the blog as soon as possible
- (except 12.00pm 1.00pm).

  Completed learning can be uploaded or be seen on the Purple Mash system meaning teachers will be monitoring progress, completion and marking throughout the day.

  Teachers may offer feedback and encouragement when receiving completed work if this is deemed helpful and/or
