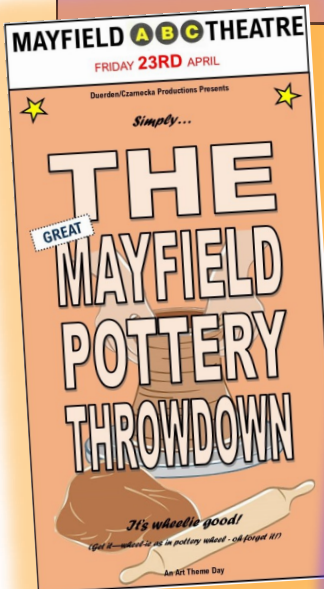

**STAGE 2: OVER TO YOU**  
(The children working independently practising and applying their knowledge and skills.)

**STAGE 3: REFINE & POLISH**  
(The essential stage -which creates the progress. Lots of improving and upskilling work. Doing it once gives you attainment. Improve work and act upon feedback and this fosters progression and deeper learning. Learning from mistakes. Improving your work. Not settling for a first attempt. All vital achievements and steps in learning that we value and enable.)
