## 'POPPITS' FIDGET ITEMS

Recently these items have become the latest craze across schools, but as ever they quickly become a force for fall-outs so reluctantly we are asking that these items **are not brought into school** and staff have been directed to ask any children bringing in them to keep them at home.

It is important to state that a small number of children use 'fidget items' as part of recommended support from external professional recommendations - who work alongside staff within school. This will continue and is not a case of double standards and will only be allowed when it fits this criteria. This criteria is not down to parental request - it is part of a wider external programme of support. Parent request cannot be considered and neither can random external suggestions. For obvious reasons we have to carefully manage this in order to be consistent and to ensure it meets a very clear need and purpose as directed by those professionals supporting school directly.
