AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE....

...learning about: place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division and money throughout this term.

AS READERS AND WRITERS....

AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE.....

SCIENCE: Living Things & Their Habitats - Begin to consider animal habitats and their essential role in providing basic needs.

AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE.....

GEOGRAPHY: Where in the world? Part Two. Within the theme, children will be introduced to animals from across the world and their natural habitats. Revisiting continents and **focusing more directly upon oceans** – introduce Equator. Non-European contrasting country: Australia (Great Barrier Reef, Outback)

HISTORY : This study looks at the role, use and perception of animals at different times in history i.e. WWI, Victorian Britain, Farming, Food, Animals for Entertainment (Circus), Exploration (Space)

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: Is it possible to be kind to everyone all of the time? Consider the Good Samaritan and The Paralysed Man parables. Then, as we consider Christmas, we ask why God gave Jesus to the world.
