After the completion of our consultation process (please see the Weekly News Issue 36 for full details), we are now in a position to announce our uniform and supporting plans from 2nd September 2021 onwards. The following list is unisex. There is no separate list for boys and girls. **Please read this important two sided letter in full for all details around the uniform and the complete offer we are making.**

TRACKSUIT PE UNIFORM – TWO DAYS PER WEEK TO BE DETERMINED BY EACH YEAR GROUP

Dark Blue Hoodie with New Badge

Dark Blue Tracksuit Bottoms with New Badge

(Optional round/crew neck plain white t-shirt may be worn underneath the hoodie.)

Trainers (No flashing sole lights or heeels please.)

FORMAL UNIFORM – THREE DAYS PER WEEK TO BE DETERMINED BY EACH YEAR GROUP

Navy round/crew neck sweatshirt or Navy cardigan (with new badge printed on) **V-NECK JUMPERS ARE NO LONGER PART OF THE UNIFORM**

White polo shirt (no badge required) **NOT COTTON BUTTON UP BLOUSE OR LONG SLEEVED BUTTON UP SHIRT.**

Dark Grey – trousers/skirt/shorts or Light Blue gingham dress (as present)

Socks/tights – grey/black/white (grey is the preferable colour)

Plain Black Shoes **(Rubber soles must be black please.)**

** Please note footwear must not contain any other prominent colours, designs or any logos.*

AS PER THE CURRENT YEAR, TIES ARE NO LONGER PART OF SCHOOL UNIFORM AND SHOULD NOT BE WORN.

SWIMMING (Year 6 children)

Swimming trunks (not shorts)/One piece swimming costume

Towel

We will share the tracksuit days with each family before the end of this term.

Please note that the old school badge will not form part of the school uniform.

It has been phased out of use in school and therefore branded items need to have the new badge on them.



** Children should have their natural hair colour. Hair dye is not permitted.

** Make up must not be worn - including nail varnish.

** Hair bands or clips must be small and discrete. They should not be 'oversized and overtly colourful'.

** Please clearly name all items of your children's clothing. We cannot take responsibility for missing items.

WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND AGAINST WEARING ANY JEWELLERY (STUD EARRINGS MAY BE WORN BUT WE STRONGLY ADVISE AGAINST THIS AND RESERVE THE RIGHT TO ASK FOR THEM TO BE REMOVED IF THEY PRESENT A RISK TO A CHILD'S SAFETY DURING PARTICULAR ACTIVITIES). CHILDREN ARE NOT PERMITTED TO WEAR EARRINGS FOR PE. IF IT IS YOUR CHILD'S PE DAY THEN PLEASE ENSURE THESE ARE TAKEN OUT AT HOME PRIOR TO ATTENDING SCHOOL THAT DAY. EARRINGS ARE NOT PERMITTED DURING SWIMMING SESSIONS. WATCHES MAY BE WORN BUT ONLY WHEN THE CHILDREN ARE ABLE TO USE THEM TO TELL THE TIME! SMART WATCHES ARE NOT PERMITTED IN SCHOOL AND WILL BE KEPT BY SCHOOL AND RETURNED TO FAMILIES IF BROUGHT IN.

AFFORDABILITY & ACCESSIBILITY

Only three items will contain the school badge. Tracksuit Hoodie; Tracksuit Bottoms; Sweatshirt or Cardigan. The rest do not require any kind of branding. Thereby keeping costing of such items to a minimum.

We will be working exclusively in partnership with **Top Marque** for our branded items they are a highly experienced, long established and trusted local provider for school uniforms. We feel it is important to work with local suppliers who have a shared interest in the community and who have a face at the end of the transaction and remain around to assist with any concerns. They have a vested interest in the quality of the service and product and we feel this is important. This is a major advantage over website based companies. We also feel that their prices are competitive when considering the relevant quality of products we analysed. They have worked with us throughout this process to create an offer that fits our needs. We have worked together to determine the most durable and comfortable combination and are content that their products meet with our hopes and aspirations. We are not working with any other supplier, including online companies, and any other supplier would not be endorsed by school directly and school takes no responsibility for the quality of branded products, and the service, bought from other suppliers. Please be aware of this. We therefore recommend using **Top Marque** for all branded uniform. We are also in the process of placing our badge under Copyright to school. It is worth considering this information when deciding where to buy branded items from.

Whilst we would recommend **Top Marque** for all quality non-branded items as well, you will still be able to collect items that do not require the school badge from your usual supermarkets, Primark etc..

From September, the shop will have a more permanent setting and weekly opening times for continued purchase and access to school uniform.

It is our hope that we can develop our range of branded items to book bags, water bottles etc... in due course.

You will access the shop from the playground gates as usual.
