DID YOU KNOW? FUNDED HELP FOR WRAPAROUND COSTS



If you need/want to use our wraparound offer: Breakfast Early Risers Club from 7.30am or After School's Cool until 5.30pm, and if you are eligible for Universal Credit childcare (covering up to 85% of the costs) or Tax-Free Children (covering 20% of costs) then this can be used to help make provision affordable.

We already have a number of families who use these routes to help afford provision. Our costs are the lowest in the area, but they still mount up and can be a burden and barrier for families. Check out if you are eligible because you may be able to access the wraparound offer using these funding options.
