SCHOOL UNIFORM THOUGHTS

We wanted to update you on some thoughts moving forward regarding uniform.

From Wednesday 15th January, the second week back in Spring Term, we will be giving families the option of wearing tracksuit uniform on Wednesdays in addition to the usual Thursdays and Fridays.

We are expanding this to allow for more physical education opportunities in the weekly timetable. The government places high expectations on physical activity time in schools and we are finding it difficult to deliver everything we need to (particularly in the colder Autumn and Winter weather) during Thursday and Friday. So by adding an optional tracksuit Wednesday it gives us the opportunity to timetable everything we want to do and need to do.

We want to be really clear, that families should not go out and buy lots of new uniform or disregard the formal uniform normally worn on those days, so Wednesday is an optional tracksuit day meaning that families can decide whether formal uniform or tracksuits should be worn.

Children will still take part in their physical education lessons in either scenario but cost and use

for uniform are very important and keeping parental choice for Wednesdays means that everyone has the option to make best use of the uniform they currently have.

Monday and Tuesday: FORMAL UNIFORM

Wednesday: OPTIONAL TRACKSUIT DAY OR FORMAL UNIFORM

Thursday & Friday: TRACKSUIT DAYS

It is now four years since we revised and reviewed uniform at school with your help. We will therefore be undertaking a wider consultation around uniform during Spring Term 2025. Our new Parental Liaising Governor: Gemma Clark will lead the consultation alongside myself. We will be reviewing cost, availability and the kind of uniform worn and asking you all for your thoughts with 2025/2026 school year in mind. We will also be discussing this at Mayfield Together and Parent Forum on Thursday 6th February. We want your thoughts about the way forward. (Mr Denton)
