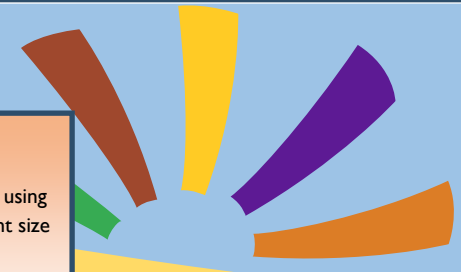

YOUR LOCALITY

What can you see outside your window?
Can you draw what you can see?
Now try a view from different window.

YOUR LOCALITY

Take a walk to the beach and make a sculpture using items you can find e.g. driftwood, shells, different size pebbles, feathers and sand.

COLLAGE

Make a collage of a local landmark e.g. Blackpool Tower, Lytham Windmill, St Annes Pier, Pleasure Beach. This could be using different types of paper, card, fabrics or natural objects including, twigs, leaves and pebbles.

COLOUR

Make a colour wheel using coloured pencils or paint.
Look at the colours in your garden or on the local park and try to create the same colours.

PRINTING

Collect different types and sizes of leaves from different trees and use them to create a leaf printing picture.
Paint the leaves and print onto paper. Alternatively, use a potato to carve out some leaf print designs, paint & print.

DRAWING

Draw an observational drawing of different types of flowers you can find either on the park, in a garden or even in a vase.

Look closely at what you are drawing to include all the details.

DRAWING

Make an observational drawing of either a self portrait or a family member or pet.

Try to get the proportion of the facial details correct.
Study closely your subject, look in a mirror or even use a photograph.

HOME LEARNING IDEAS: ART

COMPUTER ART

Use Purple Mash 'Art' section. Using '2 Paint a picture' and have a go at creating different styles on the computer e.g. Impressionism, acrylic, swirly, pattern, polychrome, mosaic, lines and many more!

ARTIST STUDY

Study an artist you like. Find out about the style of their artwork. Write a fact file about them and have a go at creating art in the style of that artist. Can you find an artist from our local area or from the North West of England?

SKETCHING

Use different media to sketch a picture of your choice. Try using pencils, pens, pastels, charcoal, etc.
Use different techniques on your picture like cross hatching, stippling, and blending.

PAINTING

Draw and paint a scene from your local area.
Think about detail and colours you can see.

SHADING

Practice shading techniques going from dark to light. Draw a piece of fruit and think about where you need shading on your picture. Is one area lighter or darker than another? Try to show this by shading.

PAINTING

Draw and colourwash a sunset or sun rise picture.
Observe the different colours and create a skyline in front of your painting.
