AS MATHEMATICIANS....

We will be learning about statistics, properties of shapes and a series of problem solving projects during

Summer Term 2.

AS READERS AND WRITERS....

We will learning about a range of fiction and non- fiction texts. Our reading will include classic fiction and autobiographies. Our writing will include persuasion, discussion, diaries and re-tellings.

AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE.....
