AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE....

This term we will be looking at place value. We will also be looking at addition and subtraction and move into multiplication and division. We will also look at measurement and area in the

AS READERS AND WRITERS....

We will be studying Greek myths and writing our own 'Greek Gods' guide.

We will then move on to consider fables and a news item about the first Olympic Games.

AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE.....

SCIENCE: We will be investigating properties of materials and in particular how they change due to temperature and other environmental factors.

AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE.....

GEOGRAPHY: A study of volcanoes as the children take a historical civilization study into Greece. The children will look at active and extinct volcanoes in Greece and the Greek Islands i.e. Santorini, Methana.

HISTORY: The growth of the Greek nation: their beliefs; their architecture; their food; their way of life; their society - including the Olympic origins.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: We will be comparing Christian and Sikh forms of worship then considering the Christmas story as one of the key events on the Christian calendar.

AS COMMUNICATORS WE ARE.....

COMPUTING: Using Code Chimp to create an animation for a Greek Myth. We will also re-visit e-safety this term and consider again how to be as safe as possible online.

FRENCH: We focusing upon language for the home and for dining out during our studies this term.
