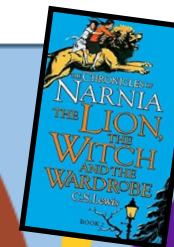

AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE....

This term we are studying multiplication and division. Then moving onto money and statistics and finishing our work with length, perimeter and fractions.

AS READERS AND WRITERS....

This term our writing will include themes linked to Anglo-Saxons and Vikings.

We will also complete a poetry unit and then a report about life in Britain in the centuries after the Roman exit.

AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE.....

SCIENCE: We will be making comparisons and developing knowledge into how fossils and soil are formed and the children will undertake a series of fair tests related to Anglo-Saxons, Vikings and a compass challenge within their forces and magnets work.

AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE.....

GEOGRAPHY: We will touch upon Germany and Scandinavia as the relevant Saxon and Viking homelands. We will be learning about the seven kingdoms of Saxon England and relevant rivers and mountains. We will also continue to develop our knowledge of towns, cities and counties in the modern UK with our atlas and map work.

HISTORY We will build upon what the children have learned previously in the Roman Invasion theme and consider the struggle between the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings that followed in the centuries ahead. We will study the significant figures and leaders and consider whether life improved in the centuries after the Roman exit.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: We will be studying Jesus' miracles and understanding the idea of forgiveness in relation to Easter - considering the question 'What is good about Good Friday?'

AS COMMUNICATORS WE ARE.....

COMPUTING: Recording and electronic communication moves on a stage, with the creation of a mock podcast from the National Trust: Sutton Hoo discovery site.

FRENCH: We will learning the language of animals and fruits this term.

AS YOUNG PEOPLE WE ARE...

The value of rules and laws; rights, freedoms and responsibilities. How the internet is used; assessing information online. Different jobs and skills; job stereotypes; setting personal goals.
